

# Collection Envelope

## Materials

White paper or light weight cardstock

Markers, Crayons, paint, brushes & pens or pencils

Glue or double stick tape

Embossing tool & Metal Edged ruler for scoring (optional)

Krylon Webbing Spray Paint (optional)

## Directions

Using the pattern, trace and cut out the envelope on white paper or lightweight cardstock. Score the paper on the fold lines. Have students decorate one side of the envelope with markers, crayons or paint. Fold sides in first, then bottom

## Decoration Ideas

- Bright colors much like the Kente cloth found in African countries
- Words or phrases to motivate them to collect donations
- Purchase Krylon Webbing sprays, have students decorate envelope and then spray them with a contrasting color. They come in black, silver, white and gold. The paint creates a textured web-like finish on the paper.

Don't forget to have students put their names on their envelopes.
