

# Colored Glue Earth Window Cling

## Materials

A picture of the earth approximately the size of a margarine lid (to be used as a pattern-*sample attached*)

Clean and dry round margarine bowl lid

Clear plastic wrap or acetate cut into a circle the size of the margarine carton lid

2 small bottles of all-purpose white glue (Elmer's)

blue and green food coloring.

## Directions

Add several drops of blue food coloring to one container of glue and shake until all the glue is blue. Repeat with green in the other bottle. Place the earth pattern inside the margarine lid. Place a piece of plastic wrap or acetate on top of that. Using a blunt edged object push the plastic into the lip of the lid. Using the colored glue "draw and color" following the earth pattern filling the lid completely. (This doesn't have to be exact) Let dry. Drying time depends on the thickness of the glue. Thicker items could take overnight. When completely dry it should pop easily out of the lid. Stick the earth on the window. To restore the cling, rinse in water.

Warning: keep item away from extreme heat. Melting may stain carpets and furniture.
